Competitors must be 14 years of age or older on race day. The race starts at 06h00. The official cut off time is 07h40.

5km Family Run

The 5km Family run starts at 06h30 or as soon as the first 10km runner is finished. Cut off time is at 07h40. Race bands must be worn on the arms and be visible at all times. Competitors must be 9 years or older. Medals to ALL finishers in the 5km event.

Medals

10km - Gold medals to the first 5 men and ladies as well as the winners of the different age categories. Silver medals will be awarded to the next 150 athletes and bronze medals to all finishers within the cut-off for the 10km races.

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General race Information:

- Entries may be handed in at Brian Bands or Sportsmans Warehouse or online on <u>www.webtickets.co.za</u>. The closing date for all pre-entries will be 17h00 on Wednesday 22 January 2025.
- Collection of numbers and late entries will be available at Westbourne Oval on FRIDAY 24 January 2025 from 14h00 to 18h00 and at the race venue from 05h00 on the morning of the race.
- Athletes must display the 2024/2025 licence numbers on the front and back of the vest/shirt and official race number placed over the licence number with ASA advertising visible. The race number contains a chip and must not be bent.
- Athletes who are not licensed members of a club affiliated to ASA must purchase a temporary license to be worn on the back of vest or plain coloured T-shirt, with the official race number on the front of the vest/T-shirt.
- Temporary licenced athletes are not covered by ASA group insurance and are encouraged to join an athletics club.
- Age category tags must be worn on front and back of your vest, clearly visible, if you wish to qualify for category prizes.
- 7. Prize winners may be requested to provide proof of age.
- Wearing of earphones are not allowed and may lead to disqualification.
- 9. The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
- 10. The Prize Giving will commence at 07h45. Athletes to be dressed in club kit when receiving prizes.
- 11. Full results will also be posted on www.epathletics.co.za.
- 12. No Alcohol may be brought onto the premises.
- 13. Entry fees are non-refundable.
