

ROUTE

25. The 50km route is a circular route starting and finishing at Pollok beach, running through Summerstrand, Walmer, Mount Pleasant, Seaview, Schoenmakerskop and back along Marine Drive. The 10km route is an out and back loop towards Noordhoek and back.

PARKING AND ROAD CLOSURES

26. Parking is available on the grass area at Pollok beach accessible from 4th avenue and 8th avenue.
 27. No road closures are planned for this event except Marine Drive from Admiralty Way to Noordhoek Skiboat club between 06h15 and 08h00.
 28. Please run facing traffic at all times and obey the marshals and traffic officials.

REFRESHMENT STATIONS

29. Refreshment tables will serve water sachets at all points, and cups with coke from 9km onwards.
 30. Refuse Bins will be provided along the route up to 400m past the water point. Litter **MUST** be discarded into the very large areas. Intentional littering and littering in non-designated areas, may lead to instant disqualification. Our waterpoint staff are all volunteers. Please do not drop your empty sachets on the ground, but disperse into a bin provided.

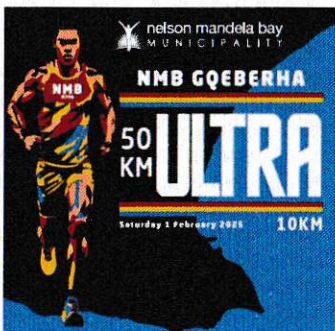

EVENT INFORMATION

- The 50km run will start at 05h00.
- The 10km run will start at 06h15.
- Entries are available online on www.webtickets.co.za/Gqeberha ultra.
- Manual entries can be handed in at Brian Bands sports, UD Sports and Sportsmans Warehouse.
- Free race Tshirt will be available for the first 200 entries received for the 50km event.
- Closing date for pre-entries will be 17h00 on Wednesday 29 January 2025.
- The cut off time for the 50km is 6 ½ hours (11h30). There will be an official cut off time on the route at the 42.2km timing mat at 10h30 (5h30).
- The 10km cut off time will be 1h45 minutes (08h00)
- Timing will be done gun to mat.
- Collection of race numbers as well as late entries, will be available on Friday 31 January 2025 between 14h00 and 20h00 from Pollok Beach, as well as from 04h00 on the morning of the event.
- Prize giving will be held at 08h00 for the 10km event and 11h30 for the Ultra. Athletes are requested to wear club kit at the prize giving.

GENERAL RULES

- The race number contains a chip and must under no circumstances be folded.
- Athletes must be licensed members of a club affiliated to ASA.
- Athletes must run in official Club colours with the Official race number on the front and 2024/2025 licence numbers on the back and front of vest/tshirt.
- Unlicensed runners must purchase a temporary licence with their entry, to be worn on the back of attire. International athletes will be provided with the necessary temporary license as per ASA rules.
- Athletes must be at least 20 years or older to participate in the 50km and 14 years or older for the 10km.
- Organised in accordance with the rules and regulations of ASA and EPA. All athletes indemnify the National, Provincial and Regional bodies, sponsors and organizers against all and any actions of whatsoever nature.
- All Traffic Officials, Technical Officials and marshals must be obeyed. Breach of any regulation or requirement may lead to instant removal without appeal. The race organiser and safety officer have final decision in this regard.
- The wearing of earphones or headsets is not permitted due to safety reasons and will lead to disqualification.
- Race venue is an alcohol free zone. Club gazebo's are welcomed to be placed in the designated area at the race village.
- The wearing of age category tags are compulsory to be eligible for prize money.
- It is every athletes responsibility to read, and comply with these requirements. No contraventions will be entertained.
- All finishers will receive an event medal. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the overall Male and Female winners at the finish line.
